## From Nurse Jen Three Reasons to Keep Your Child Home From School

1. Your child does not feel well enough to participate in normal activities.
2. Your child needs more care than staff can give and still care for other children.
3. Your child's illness is on this list:

- Diarrhea
- Fever (100 degrees – child should be fever free for 24 hours without medication before returning to school)
  - Flu-like symptoms
  - Cough (severe, uncontrolled or wheezing)
  - Rash with fever
  - Vomiting

If your child presents with these symptoms during the day, you will be called to pick him/her up.

\*\*Colorado law states that **ALL** over the counter medications (including cough drops, etc.) and prescriptions need a doctor's order to be given at school.
