Additionally, the Board oversees Administration, who is responsible for day-to-day management of education programs and responsible for the financial management of the corporation. Overall, the members of the Board of Directors contribute to the educational, management, legal, and financial skills needed to ensure long-term organizational stability and ensure year-to-year educational excellence for GLOBE Charter School. The Board of Directors has seven elected voting members, with terms of two years. Two Board of Directors appointed members, with terms of one year from the date of appointment.

Board of Directors responsibilities includes; attendance at all in-person meetings per year, as well as teleconference meetings and active electronic conversations as part of Board of Directors subcommittees. At times, the Board of Directors have held additional meetings that may require attendance.

Board of Directors members also hold a fiduciary responsibility for management of organizational capital and ensuring appropriate filings with federal, state, and local authorities consistent with the Charter contract and incorporation status as a 501c3 non-profit organization. The corporation's attendance policy for directors allows for removal if three meetings are missed without notice.

Declaration of Candidacy
